A—B as shown coloured brown.  
That part of a footpath of undefined width commencing at a point 25 yards north-east of its junction with Mill Lane and 190 yards south-south-east of the junction of the said Mill Lane with the King's Worthy to Alresford Road (B.3047) and running in a general north-easterly direction across Field O.S. Parcel No. 139 and through an existing farm building for a total distance of 230 yards to its termination at a point 60 yards south-west of its junction with the said Road B.3047 at a point 300 yards east of the junction of that Road with the said Mill Lane. That part of a footpath of undefined width commencing at its junction with Moorgreen Road (C.42) at a point approximately 400 yards east-north-east of the Southampton Arms Public House and running in a south-easterly direction across Field O.S. Parcel No. 626 for a distance of approximately 150 yards to its junction with an existing footpath (Footpath No. 9 at West End) at a point approximately 170 yards south-south-west of the junction of the said Footpath No. 9 with Moorgreen Road and continuing in a general southerly direction across the said Field O.S. Parcel No. 626 and Field O.S. Parcel No. 623 for a distance of approximately 387 yards to its termination at a point 270 yards south-east of the allotment gardens (Field O.S. Parcel No. 619). A footpath 4 feet wide commencing at its junction with an existing footpath (Footpath No. 9 at West End) at a point approximately 360 yards south-south-east of the junction of the said Footpath No. 9 with Moorgreen Road and approximately 330 yards south-west of Berrywood Farm, running parallel and alongside the eastern boundaries of Fields O.S. Parcel Nos. 626 and 623 in a southerly direction for approximately 20 yards, thence in a south-easterly direction for approximately 23 yards, thence in a south-westerly direction for approximately 308 yards, thence in a north-westerly direction along the western boundary of the said O.S.
