WORCESTER CITY COUNCIL

Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that the Worcester City Council propose to make Orders under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be

- (a) to amend the existing Traffic Regulation Order in respect of the north side of Shaw Street by extending for a distance of 20 feet the length of road from its junction with Farrier Street along which the waiting of vehicles is at present prohibited;
- (b) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the west side of Loves Grove between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. from Mondays to Saturdays;
- (c) to prohibit at all times the waiting of vehicles along certain lengths of the west side of Sansome Walk and to restrict waiting to 45 minutes in any two hours along the remaining lengths;
- (d) upon completion of the reconstruction of Tybridge Street, to introduce a one-way system of traffic working in respect of the proposed New Road/Tybridge Street/Hylton Road gyratory; and to prohibit or restrict the waiting of vehicles along the roads specified.

The proposed Orders which will contain the usual exceptions relating to loading and unloading of vehicles etc., and plans showing the roads to which the proposed Orders relate, may be inspected at my office or at the City Library, Foregate Street during normal working hours.
