WAGES COUNCILS ACT 1959

Brush and Broom Wages Council (Great Britain)

The Brush and Broom Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity proposals for (1) amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Brush and Broom) (Holidays) Order 1963 (Order M. (97)) as amended by Schedule 2 to the Wages Regulation (Brush and Broom) Order 1967 (Order M. (105)) and (2) the revocation of Order M. (97) and Schedule 2 to Order M. (105).

The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the above-mentioned proposals if made to it within 14 days from 3rd January 1969.
