REPORT BY THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

Pay of agricultural workers in England and Wales

On 3rd January 1969, in pursuance of their powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity and the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food referred to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for their report the question of the pay of agricultural workers in England and Wales. The Board has now made its report entitled "Pay of Workers in Agriculture in England and Wales". In accordance with section 5 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity and the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food hereby give notice that the report was first published as Command Paper Number 3911 on 30th January 1969.
