PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966 REPORT BY THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

Pay and Conditions of Service of Engineering Workers (Final Report)

On 12th May 1967, in pursuance of their powers under section 2(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and the Minister of Labour referred to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination:

(1) the working of the current engineering long-term agreement, including its effect on earnings levels and differentials, productivity, costs and prices and

(2) the pay and conditions of service of supervisory, clerical, technical and similar workers in the engineering industry.

The Board has now made its final report on these questions and in accordance with section 5(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity hereby gives notice that this report was first published as Command Paper Number 3931 on 20th February 1969.
