N Saturday laft in the Evening Arrives here the Count Guldenlow from London, where he has been fome dayes I cognito; and is, upon the Death of his Majefty of Danemark, returning home with all fpeed : and accordingly embarked the fame Evening upon one of the Packet-Boats, which failed the fame night : The Danish Man of Wat continues still here.

Rome, Feb. 15. As yet we cannot guels at the Person which will be chosen to forceed in the Papacy, The heads of the leveral Factions not being able to get any confiderable advantages upon one another. Cardinal Chigy though fallen ill of a dangerous squinancy & would not give the other Faction any advantage by his absence from the Conclave, but chose rather to dispence with the inconveniences of the place, but is by bleeding and the application of proper Remedies upon a hopeful way of Recovery. Cardinal Videni though a Creature of the Chigy has loft much of his interest, and the good opinion of the people, who have fnewn their ill efteem of him by feveral Palquilsy and the toth inftant more egregioufly fixing his Effigies upon the Gibbet srected upon the Place of St. Peter in the view of the Conclave.

"Gardinal d' Elci-hath been this week excluded by Cardinal d' Effe, in behalf of the French ; and Cardinal Busivifi by Cardinal de Medici, in the name of the Spani-

ardi, The Cardinals Imperiale and Urfini are returned into, and Santa the Conclave, but Piccolomini, Spada, Antonio, and Santa Croce fiil ablent 3- the 3 former continue indilpos'd, but the last-somewhat recover'd from his Gour.

Cardinal Antonio finds himfelf fo ill and Heftical, that, despairing of the recovery of his Health, he is preparing. himfelf for another V Vorld:

Vienna, Feb. 21. The Empreis Dowager and the Arch-Durchels the Juture Queen of Poland, are well advanced on their way for Czenftochom, paffing every day about 5. or 6 German Leggues. The Regiment of Schmidt which conducted them as farr as the Borders of Silefia, is returned and Ordered to march into Hungary, for the fecurity of the Peace of that Kingdom.

This week was held a Councel of the Principal Lords and Nability of Hungary, where prefided the Prince de Labhdwits Vice Prefident of the Councel of War, which ending, his Imperial Majelfy 'ent away the Count Nadafti, Vice-Palatine of Hungary, to affure thole States, that he was griolved to Employ his whole force ( if their affairs. should require it ) to defend them against the Turks, if .

they should make any attempts upon them. Two dayes force was found at the Doot of the Fountain, <sup>1</sup> which furnishes watet to the Pallace, a Dogg, which had been poilon'd with a great quantity of Arfenic and Vitriol, which some Villain was believed to have brought thither, with an intention to have poifon'd the Fountain ; there being found near the place an Axe, with other InAruments, which might have been employ'd for the forcing open the Door of the Fountain, which he was supposed to have left behind him, for fear of being furprized in the Fact.
