Any person aggrieved by the Scheme and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1961 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of any regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Scheme, may, within six weeks from 4th March 1969, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Scheme or of any provision contained therein.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Trunk Road (Hewlett Road, Cheltenham) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1969

The Minister of Transport has made an Order under sections 1 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 the effect of which is to revoke and re-enact with amendment existing waiting restrictions in that length of the A.46 Trunk Road known as Hewlett Road in the Borough of Cheltenham, so that waiting is prohibited at any time between its junctions with Berkeley Place and Fairview Road as well as between its junctions with High Street and Berkeley Place.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, or to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.
