The City of Salford (Regent Road/Eccles New Road) (Revocation of Traffic Orders) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Salford City Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be to revoke whole or parts of existing Traffic Regulation Orders as follows:

- (1) The parts of the "City of Salford (Goodiers Lane, West Egerton Street, Windsor Street, Regent Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1963", relating to:
 - (a) both sides of Goodiers Lane for a distance of 22 yards in a southerly direction from Regent Road;
 - (b) the east side of West Egerton Street from Regent Road to Robinson Street and the west side from Regent Road to East Taylor Street;
 - (c) the west side of Windsor Street from Regent Road to Trevor Street and the east side from Regent Road to East Taylor Street; and

- (4) The whole of the "City of Salford (Eccles New Road) (Ladywell Hospital) (No Waiting) Order, 1964".
- (5) The part of the "City of Salford (Derby Street) (No Waiting) Order, 1965", relating to the east side of Derby Street and to the west side for a distance of 15 yards in a southerly direction from Regent Road.
- (6) The part of the "City of Salford (Weaste Road South) (No Waiting) Order, 1966", relating to the east side of Weaste Road South and to the west side for a distance of 10 yards in a southerly direction from Eccles New Road.
- (7) The part of the "City of Salford (Vere Street) (No Waiting) Order, 1967", relating to both sides of Vere Street for a distance of 12 yards in a southerly direction from Eccles New Road.
- (8) The parts of the "City of Salford (Regent Road) (No Waiting) Order, 1965", relating to:

 - (d) both sides of Wesley Street for a distance of 15 yards in a southerly direction from Regent Road;
 - (e) the east side of West Craven Street from a point 30 yards south of Regent Road to a point 33 yards south of Regent Road, and the west side for a distance of 10 yards in a southerly direction from Regent Road;
 - (f) the east side of Doddington Street for a distance of 17 yards in a southerly direction from Regent Road;
 - (g) the west side of Ellesmere Street for a distance of 10 yards in a southerly direction from Regent Road;
 - (h) both sides of West Burton Street from Regent Road to the passages rear of 299 and 301 Regent Road;
 - (i) the east side of West Worsley Street from Regent Road to passage at gable No. 1 West Worsley Street, and the west side for a distance of 10 yards in a southerly direction from Regent Road;
 - (j) the west side of West Brownbill Street for a distance of 20 yards in a northerly direction from Regent Road and the east side from Regent Road to passage rear of 442 Regent Road;
 - (k) both sides of Meter Street;
 - (l) the east side of North Phoebe Street for a distance of 16 yards in a northerly direction from Regent Road;
 - (m) both sides of Glasshouse Street; and
 - (n) both sides of Rennie Street.
