Different rates of interest apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity.

FARNHAM URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Urban District of Farnham (Ridgway Road and Edward Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Farnham Urban District Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the undermentioned lengths of road between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive:

- Ridgway Road, south-east side, from a point 36 feet north-east of its junction with Edward Road to a point 36 feet south-west of the same junction.
- Edward Road, both sides from its junction with Ridgway Road for a distance of 36 feet.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the lengths of road to which the proposed Order relates may be inspected at the Council Offices, South

Street, Farnham, Surrey, between the hours of 8.40 a.m. and 1 p.m. and 2.15 p.m. and 5.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.
