The Borough of Swindon (St. Mary's Grove and Osborne Street Back Roads) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1969.

Notice is hereby given that the Swindon Borough Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be that no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle so that it shall enter or leave (a) The back road between numbers 50 and 52 Osborne Street at its junction with Osborne Street; (b) the back road alongside number 79 St. Mary's Grove at its junction with the back road serving St. Mary's Grove.
