### ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

ASHINGTON URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL  
*The Urban District Council of Ashington (Green Lane) (Box Junction) Order 1969*

Notice is hereby given that the Ashington Urban District Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968. The effect of the proposed Order is that no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive a vehicle into the boxed area over the Railway Level Crossing in Green Lane, Ashington, and thereafter drive it in such a direction that it becomes necessary, owing to the presence of stationary vehicles, for any part of the vehicle to remain at rest within the area. Nothing in the proposed Order shall apply in relation to vehicles used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or civil defence purposes.

### LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Leicester (Parish of Braunstone) (Prohibition of Cycling) Order, 1968*

Notice is hereby given that on the 21st April 1969, the Leicester County Council made the above-named Order, the effect of which is to prohibit the riding of cycles, tricycles and mopeds in the lengths of the three pedestrian sub-ways beneath Narborough Road South, Trunk Route A.46, which lie beneath the two service roads adjacent thereto. ## CIVIC AMENITIES ACTS

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
CIVIC AMENITIES ACT, 1967—SECTION 1

*Banbury Conservation Area*

Notice is hereby given in accordance with section 1 (4) of the Civic Amenities Act 1967, that the Oxfordshire County Council by formal instrument dated the 30th April 1969, designated the area in the Borough of Banbury shown edged red on the plan Ref. CONS/B/1 a Conservation Area for the purpose of section 1 of the Civic Amenities Act, 1967.

Accordingly, special attention will be paid to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the area in the exercise, with respect to any buildings or other land in the area, of any powers under Part I of the Historic Buildings and Ancient Monuments Act, 1953, the Local Authorities (Historic Buildings) Act, 1962, or the Town and Country Planning Acts 1962 to 1968. In this connection the Council have decided that account should be taken of the views expressed by the County Architect in his Conservation Study No. 2 for Banbury as well as of all other relevant factors.

A certified true copy of the formal instrument dated the 30th April 1969, and the plan Ref. CONS/B/1 referred to above and a copy of the County Architect's Conservation Study No. 2 have been placed on deposit for public inspection at:

- (3) Town Clerk's Office, Municipal Offices, Marlborough Road, Banbury, Oxon.

The copies of the instrument and plan and of the Conservation Study so deposited are available for inspection free of charge by all persons interested at the places mentioned above between the hours of 9 a.m. and 12.45 p.m. and between 2.15 p.m. and 5.15 p.m. on every weekday except Saturday.
