

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A
LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Mersey & Weaver River Authority by The Peerless Refining Company (Liverpool) Limited of Dunnings Bridge Road, Bootle, Liverpool 10, to vary Licence No. 25/69/30/11 to abstract water from the sandstone underground strata at two boreholes on the licence holders premises at Dunnings Bridge Road, Bootle, Liverpool 10, National Grid Reference SJ 362989.

The variation applied for is For a period of two years to amend the permitted rate of abstraction as follows (1) from 40,000 gallons per hour to 50,000 gallons per hour; (2) from 0.96 million gallons per day to 1.2 million gallons per day, but (3) with no change in the total yearly rate of abstraction

BURNLEY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Burnley (No. 11) Smoke Control Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Burnley in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 7th day of May 1969 made an Order entitled The Burnley (No 11) Smoke Control Order, 1969, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding Ten pounds unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation until the 1st day of September 1970, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Burnley, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 23rd day of May 1969

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London SW 1, object to the confirmation of the Order.
