County Borough of Newport (Bettws Secondary School Site) Extinguishment of Public Right of Way Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on the 20th day of May 1969, is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for Wales for confirmation or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Council of the County Borough of Newport

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to extinguish the public right of way across the Bettws Secondary School Site, Bettws, running from Bettws Lane in a southerly direction a distance of 520 yards across the site to the southern boundary of that land

The Council of the County Borough of Newport is satisfied that a suitable alternative right of way will be provided over land specified in the Order

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the County Borough of Newport, may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for Wales, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
