PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966

REPORT BY THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

#### Steel Prices

On 24th December 1968, in pursuance of their powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity and the of State for Employment and Productivity and the Minister of Power referred to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination the British Steel Corporation's proposals for a new price structure, and new price levels, for iron and steel products produced by the nationalised steel industry. The Board has now made its report entitled "Steel Prices". In accordance with section 5 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity and the Minister of Power hereby give notice that the report was first published as Command Paper Number 4033 on 21st May 1969.

#### PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966 PRODUCTIVITY AGREEMENTS

Direction under section 5 (4) further extending the period within which the National Board for Prices and Incomes must publish their report.

Whereas the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, in pursuance of her powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, referred the abovementioned question to the National Board for Prices and Incomes for examination and has published the text of the reference in the Gazette on 26th November 1968.

2. And whereas by section 5 (3) of the Act, but subject to section 5 (4), the Board are required to make their report so as to allow publication within three months of the said date;

3. And whereas, in pursuance of her powers under the said section 5 (4), the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, by a direction published in the Gazette on 25th February 1969, extended the said period of three months by three months;
4. Now, therefore, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, in pursuance of her powers under the said section 5 (4), hereby directs that the said period of three months be further extended by two months.

REFERENCE TO THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES

#### Coal Prices

1. The National Coal Board has consulted the Minister of Power about price proposals affecting industrial coal produced in the East Midlands and domestic solid fuels, which would increase their revenues by about £15 million annually.

2. In pursuance of their powers under section 2 (1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, and the Minister of Power
