

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Warwick (Nelson Lane and Wharf Street, Warwick) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1969.

Notice is hereby given that the Warwickshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles (except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform) on the lengths of road mentioned in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein and to enable the vehicle to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a map showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the office of the Clerk of the Council, Shire Hall, Warwick, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 2 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and from 9 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays, and at the office of the Town Clerk, Pageant House, Jury Street, Warwick from 9 a.m. to 12.45 p.m. and from 1.45 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Objections to the proposal, which must be in writing and must specify the grounds on which they are made, must be sent to the undersigned by the 16th June 1969.

Lengths of road in the Borough of Warwick

(1) *Nelson Lane*—from its junction with Wharf Street for a distance of 13.5 metres in a north-westerly direction.

(2) *Wharf Street*—

(i) from its junction with Charles Street for a distance of 13.5 metres in a north-westerly direction ;

(ii) from a point 164.5 metres north-west of its junction with Charles Street north-westwards then south-westwards to a point 152.0 metres north-east of its junction with Cliffe Way, and

(iii) on the north-east side only from a point 13.5 metres north-west of its junction with Charles Street for a distance of 151.0 metres in a north-westerly direction. (374)

The County of Warwick (Bishops Tachbrook) (One Way Street) (Revocation) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Warwickshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to revoke The County of Warwick (Bishops Tachbrook) (One Way Street) Order, 1959, thereby making the unclassified road from the church to the junction of the Oakley Wood—Stonebridge road, A.452, in the parish of Bishops Tachbrook open to two-way traffic.

WARLEY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967 AND TRANSPORT ACT 1968

The County Borough of Warley (Experimental) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 1) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Warley on the 12th day of May 1969, made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended under Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit for a period of 6 months the driving of vehicles on any of the lengths of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this notice in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in column 2 of the said Schedule.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Town Clerk, Council House, High Street, Smethwick, Warley, Worcs, during normal office hours.

The Order will come into operation on 1st July 1969.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order is made make application for the purpose to the High Court.

WEST BROMWICH COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of West Bromwich (Heath Lane) (Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the West Bromwich County Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait at any time between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday on the sides of roads on the length of roads specified in the Schedule below.

Appropriate provision will be made to enable people to board or alight from vehicles and to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from vehicles and for building operations, demolitions and statutory purposes.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the roads to which the proposed Order relates, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the Town Hall, West Bromwich, from Monday to Friday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. and between the hours of 2 p.m. and 5.36 p.m.

Objections to the proposals, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in
