DERBY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Derby Corporation (Pear Tree Street and Other Roads) (Waiting Restrictions) Order, 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Derby County Borough Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 the effect of which is to restrict waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. as follows:

Name of Street	Restriction
Pear Tree and Rutland Street	No waiting between St. Thomas' Road and Portland Street on alternate sides on alternate days from Monday to Saturday.
Pear Tree Street	South side—No waiting along the frontage of the school premises.
Portland Street	No waiting between Pear Tree Road and Pear Tree Street on alternate sides on alternate days from Monday to Saturday.
Portland Street	West side—No waiting along the frontage of the school premises.
St. Thomas' Road	No waiting between Walbrook Road and Balaclava Road from Monday to Saturday.
Balaclava Road	No waiting from Monday to Saturday.

and to prohibit waiting at all times for a distance of 45 feet on either side of the junctions of any of the above-named roads with any other road and for a distance of 45 feet on either side of the junction of any road and with any of the above-named roads.

Vehicles used in connection with funerals, building operations and demolitions, the loading and unloading of goods and the boarding and alighting of passengers will not be affected by these proposals.

The Order will come into operation on 30th May 1969.

ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of Essex (Restricted Roads) (No. 2) Order, 1969

FOLKESTONE BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Folkestone (Traffic Regulation) (Various Roads) (No. 3) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that on the 19th May 1969, the Folkestone Borough Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which, with certain exceptions, was to prohibit the waiting of vehicles as follows:

1. In respect of the streets or parts of the streets in Schedule I of the Order a complete prohibition of waiting.

2. In respect of the streets or parts of the streets in Schedule II of the Order prohibition of waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

SCHEDULE I

Complete Prohibition of Waiting

Harbour Street, East side, from the end of the present restriction at a point 25 feet south of the junction with Tram Road in a south-easterly direction to the present restriction at the junction with Beach Street.

Tram Road, South side, from the end of the present restriction at a point 60 feet east of Harbour
