

section 6(2) of the Finance Act 1968 to wit a statement that Mohammad Ismail Khwaja was the owner of the said motor car which statement was untrue in the material particular in that Mohammad Ismail Khwaja was not the owner of the said motor car. Whereby and by force of sections 44 and 301 of the Customs and Excise Act, 1952, respectively, the said goods are liable to forfeiture.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in accordance with the said Schedule to the said Act specifying the name and address of a

solicitor in England who is authorised to accept service of process and to act on your behalf, in default of such notice the said goods will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited and will be liable to be disposed of in such manner as the Commissioners of Customs and Excise may direct. If you make such claim within the time aforesaid, legal proceedings will be taken for the condemnation thereof.
