Wye Street Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal

of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the read or the services therein.

Exceptions are also provided, except on certain days in specified roads between specified hours, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the

vehicle.

In certain specified lengths of road where vehicles are permitted to wait for limited periods the restrictions do not apply to the waiting of authorised invalid carriages.
