It is proposed to close Eastlea Avenue at its junc-tion with Westlea Avenue to vehicular traffic but it will still be possible for such traffic to gain access to Eastlea Avenue from Leander Gardens as at present.

A further proposal is to institute a boxed area in Westlea Avenue at its junction with Leander Gardens. With certain exceptions in relation to the emergency services, the Order will provide that no person shall be permitted to drive a vehicle into the boxed area and thereafter to drive it in such a direction that it becomes necessary, owing to the presence of stationary vehicles, for any part of the vehicle to remain at rest within the area. vehicle to remain at rest within the area.

The effect of the proposed one-way Order referred to at (3) above will be to permit the driving of vehicles along the service road fronting Nos. 20 to 82 Colne Way in the direction from Woodmere Avenue towards Tudor Avenue but not in the opposite direction. The proposed weight restriction Order referred to at (4) above will apply to this same length of service road so as to prevent its use by any vehicle exceeding 3 tons in weight, whether laden or unladen, unless the vehicle is being used for the conveyance of persons or goods to or from any premises in that persons or goods to or from any premises in that length of service road. Further exceptions will be provided in the weight restriction Order and these will include vehicles used in connection with certain building, reconstruction or maintenance works, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.
