WEST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of the West Riding of Yorkshire (Greenberfield Lane, Barnoldswick) (Weight Restriction) Order, 1969.

Notice is hereby given that on the 13th August 1969 the Minister of Transport consented to the coming into operation of an Order made by the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit:

- (a) any motor vehicle or trailer, being a track laying vehicle, or
- (b) any other vehicle, any axle weight of which, whether laden or unladen, exceeds 8 tons

from proceeding in that length of Greenberfield Lane at Barnoldswick in the Urban District of Barnoldswick which is carried by Greenberfield Lock Bridge (G.R. 889482) over the Leeds and Liverpool Canal.

An alternative route for vehicles affected by the Order is via the Barnoldswick and Thornton County Road (B.6252).

EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of the East Riding of Yorkshire (Various Streets, Hornsea) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Variation Order, 1969.

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the Administrative County of York, East Riding, propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84 (D) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to vary "The County of the East Riding of Yorkshire (Various Streets, Hornsea) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1967" so as to provide for the following additional restrictions and modifications:

- (a) the prohibition of waiting at any time on the south side of Newbegin from its junction with Market Place eastwards for a distance of 20 yards;

- (b) the prohibition of waiting between the hours of 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. during the period from Good Friday to the 31st October inclusive in any year on the under-mentioned streets and parts of streets:

Railway Street west side

Esplanade

east side from the junction with Headland View to the junction with Hartley Street;
west side from the junction with Eastgate to the junction with Headland View

Alexandra Road north and south sides

Sands Lane north side from the junction with Broadway to the junction with Parva Road

Parva Road south-east side

Cliff Road east and west sides from the junction with Hartley Street northwards for a distance of 20 yards.

- (c) the prohibition of waiting between the hours of 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays during the period from Good Friday to the 31st October inclusive in any year on the under-mentioned streets:

Westbourne Road north-east side

Victoria Avenue east side

Park Row south side

Grosvenor Road west side.

Exceptions will be made in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary to enable persons to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the streets or the services therein.

WEST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire Moor Road, Wath upon Dearne

(Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the West Riding of Yorkshire propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting by vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in Moor Road between its junction with High Street (A.6023) and its junction with the un-named road leading to Brewery Terrace, Wath upon Dearne.
