RUNCORN URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Runcorn Urban District Council (Heath Road South (C.751) (Part)) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1969.

RAMSGATE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Ramsgate (Various Roads) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 2, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Ramsgate Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, the effect of which will be to prohibit (with the usual exceptions) the waiting of vehicles as follows:

<i>Charlotte Court</i>		
On both sides of Charlotte Court from its junction with Harbour Street for a distance of 29 yards.	At all times.	All days throughout the year.
<i>Guildford Lawn</i>		
On both sides of Guildford Lawn from both of its junctions with George Street for a distance of 37 yards.	8 a.m. to 6 p.m.	All weekdays throughout the year.
<i>Harbour Parade</i>		
(i) On the north side of Harbour Parade between its junctions with York Street and Harbour Street.	At all times.	All days throughout the year.
(ii) On the south side from its junction with Military Road for a distance of 101 yards in a north-easterly direction.	At all times.	All days throughout the year.
<i>Meeting Street</i>		
On both sides of Meeting Street from a point 15 yards south-west of its junction with High Street for a distance of 67 yards in a south-westerly direction and from a point 15 yards north-west of its junction with George Street for a distance of 94 yards in a north-westerly direction.	At all times.	All days throughout the year.
<i>Northwood Road</i>		
On the north-west side of Northwood Road from its junction with Margate Road for a distance of 100 yards in a north-easterly direction.	8 a.m. to 8 p.m.	All weekdays throughout the year.
<i>Staffordshire Street</i>		
On both sides of Staffordshire Street for its entire length.	At all times.	All days throughout the year.
