ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under sections 74 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is that no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.
