HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

The London—Cambridge—King's Lynn Trunk Road (Southbury Road Side Roads) Order 1969

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that, in relation to the above-mentioned trunk road at Enfield in Greater London, he has made under section 9 of the above Act an Order, which authorises the Minister to carry out improvements to Southbury Road at Enfield aforesaid.

HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

The London North Circular Trunk Road (Dysons Road/Montagu Road, Edmonton, Side Roads) Order 1969

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Edmonton in the London Borough of Enfield to make under section 9 of the above Act an Order which will—

(a) authorise the Minister—

- (i) to carry out improvements to Dysons Road and Montagu Road,
- (ii) to stop up a length of Dysons Road,
- (iii) to construct new highways to connect Dysons Road with the Trunk Road and Genista Road,

all at Edmonton aforesaid, and

(b) provide for the transfer of the said new highways to the London Borough of Enfield as from the date on which the Minister notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic

THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS, 1968

Norway: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 he hereby varies the recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in Part II of the Schedule to the Notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 12th August 1938, for the importation of meat and meat products from Norway, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

In relation to meat products (including casings but excluding canned meat), recognition is restricted to those Certificates which are completed by the insertion of one of the following establishment numbers:

04, 06, 09, 13, 17, 22, 60, 69, 70, 103, 105, 106.

In relation to casings only, recognition is extended to include those Certificates which are completed by the insertion of one of the following establishment numbers:

201, 202, 203, 204, 205.

In relation solely to reindeer meat and reindeer meat products, recognition is restricted to those Certificates which are completed by the insertion of one of the following establishment numbers:

91, 92, 93.
