PRESENT,

The QUEEN'S Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas it is expedient to provide redundancy compensation terms for locally entered ratings of the Goan Division of the Royal Navy who are made redundant on the running down of the said Division:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 11 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865, and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Goan Locally Entered Ratings Redundancy Compensation Terms) Order 1969.

2. Redundancy compensation terms on the scales and under the conditions specified in the Scheme contained in the Schedule annexed hereto may be paid to Goan locally entered ratings who are made redundant on or after 10th October 1968 either in mid-engagement or at the end of an engagement when they would otherwise have been re-engaged.

These payments will be in lieu of and not additional to the gratuities to which these ratings might otherwise be entitled under the provisions of an Order in Council (4 NPP) of 12th July 1968.

SCHEME

SECTION I

SCOPE OF TERMS

1. The terms of this Scheme apply to locally entered personnel made redundant (either in mid-engagement or at the end of an engagement when they would otherwise have been re-engaged) on or after 10th October 1968, as part of the rundown of the Goan Division. They also apply to those leaving during the rundown period at the end of their full expectation of service. The terms do not apply to those leaving for any other reason, e.g. invaliding, unsuitability, misconduct, or inefficiency, or to those who choose not to re-engage while they are still able to do so, for whom the appropriate scales of gratuity already in force will continue to apply.

SECTION II

AMOUNT OF PAYMENT

2. Those covered by the terms of this Scheme will be eligible for a single lump sum payment calculated on the following basis:
