

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO
OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN
INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUND-
ING WORKS.**

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Conservators of the River Thames by David M. Young of Flat 6, 18 Buckingham Street, London W.C.2, for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of the River Kennett by means of replacement of existing sluices within the mill house with an external dam with sluice, enclosing the mill thorough and enlarging and improving a group of three sluices at Moon's Mill, Ramsbury.

The object of impounding water by means of the works is to make the house suitable for habitation and to reduce the risk of flooding.

Further details of the application are: The sluice capacity will be considerably increased.

HEBBURN URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

The Hebburn (No. 12) Smoke Control Order 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Urban District Council of Hebburn in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 18th September 1969 made an Order entitled the "Hebburn (No. 12) Smoke Control Order 1969" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Ministry of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised solid fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st October 1970, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Council Offices, Civic Centre, Campbell Park Road, Hebburn, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 5th December 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may, by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area to which this Order relates is bounded on the west, north and east by the boundaries of the Hebburn (Nos. 1, 2 and 8) Smoke Control Orders and on the south by the middle of the carriageways of parts of Hedgeley Road, Byron Avenue, Windsor Crescent, Hawthorne Avenue, Coleridge Square and Milton Avenue.

ROCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

CLEAN AIR ACTS, 1956 AND 1968

The City of Rochester (No. 5) Smoke Control Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Rochester (acting by the Council) in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (the principal Act) on the 29th day of July 1969, made an Order entitled "The City of Rochester (No. 5) Smoke Control Order, 1969", declaring the area described in the schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the principal Act—

(i) if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than authorised fuel.

(ii) any person who acquires any unauthorised solid fuel for use in a building or for use in a boiler or plant in the smoke control area or who sells by retail any unauthorised solid fuel for delivery by him or on his behalf to a building or to premises to which there is a boiler or industrial plant, in the smoke control area shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless, in the case of a person who sells by retail for delivery, he proves that he believed and had reasonable grounds for believing that either

(a) the building was an exempted building, or

(b) the buyer intended to use the fuel in an exempted fire place, boiler or plant.

The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 9th day of October 1970, or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at The Guildhall, Rochester, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 5th December 1969.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

In the City of Rochester, the area having boundaries as follows:

From the northern extremity of the City boundary on Cliffe Road, down the middle of Cliffe Road in a southerly direction to Frindsbury Road, thence along the middle of Frindsbury Road in a south-westerly direction to North Street and continuing in a southerly direction down the middle to North Street until meeting the London-Rochester railway line, thence following the centre of the railway line in a westerly direction until meeting the north-east boundary of Smoke Control Area No. 4, thence following this boundary in a westerly direction along the middle of Watling Street until reaching a point where the City boundary bears north, thence following the northern boundary of the City until reaching the aforementioned northern extremity on Cliffe Road.
