The amendment becomes operative as from the 5th December, 1969, but if any person aggrieved by it desires to question the validity thereof or any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment, he may, within 6 weeks from the 5th December 1969 make application to the High Court.

The proposals dealt with in the amendment comprise the Town Maps for Alfreton-South Normanton and Ripley and new parts of the approved Written Statement for the County Development Plan.

HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1959—SECTION 108
Silchester—Road U.251

Notice is hereby given that the Hampshire County Council propose to make application to the Magistrates' Court sitting at The Court House, London Road, Basingstoke, at 10.30 a.m. on Tuesday, the 30th December 1969, for an Order under section 108 of the Highways Act 1959, diverting that part of the road U.251 in the Parish of Silchester, where it passes over the Reading to Basingstoke railway line at a level crossing, to a new route passing through a bridge under the said railway line to the north of the said level crossing, on the grounds that it can be diverted so as to make it more commodious to the public.

A plan showing the proposed diversion coloured red has been placed on deposit at the Post Office at Silchester, where it may be inspected during normal office hours.

On the hearing of the application, the applicant authority, any person to whom notice is required to be given under Paragraph (1) of the Twelfth Schedule to the Highways Act 1959, any person who uses the road and any other person who would be aggrieved by the making of the Order applied for shall have the right to be heard.

The Urban District Council of Hinckley
Public Footpath U.70 Extinguishment Order 1969

Notice is hereby given that on 28th November 1969, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed, with modifications, the above Order.

Its effect is to extinguish the public right of way running from the A.5 Watling Street to the boundary between the Urban District and Warwickshire.

The Order becomes operative as from 25th December, 1969, but if a person, aggrieved by the Order, desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under Schedule 2 of the Act, as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 7 to the Act, within six weeks from 5th December 1969, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

Hitchin Rural District Council Bridleway No. 12
(Part) Parish of Graveley, Bridleway No. 33 (Part)
Parish of Weston, Public Path Diversion Order,
1969.

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order made on the 4th November 1969 is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation, or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Hitchin Rural District Council.

The effect of the Order if confirmed without modifications will be to divert the public right of way running from a point approximately 133 yards from the end of the county road at Wellfield Cottages continuing for approximately 484 yards in a north-easterly direction to the boundary of the parish of Graveley then continuing for approximately 300 yards to the junction of footpath No. 31 in the parish of Weston to a line running approximately 15 feet to the north from a point approximately 133 yards from the end of the county road at Wellfield Cottages thence parallel with the existing path for a distance of approximately 484 yards to the boundary of the parish of Graveley then continuing for approximately 300 yards then south for approximately 15 feet to the junction with footpath No. 31 in the parish of Weston.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at Hitchin Rural District Council, Council Offices, Grammar School Walk, Hitchin, Herts., between 8.45 a.m. and 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. and 5 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the Clerk of the Council, Hitchin Rural District Council, Council Offices, Grammar School Walk, Hitchin, Herts., before the 9th day of January 1970 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Hitchin Rural District Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Minister of Housing and Local Government, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Minister any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.
