##### *Federal Republic of Germany: Official Certificate*

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food Regulations, 1968, he hereby varies the recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 21st April 1967, for the importation of meat and meat products from the Federal Republic of Germany to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

#### LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1930

##### *Cors Y Bol Drainage District*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 4 (3) and 14 of the Land Drainage Act 1930, as applied by the Water Resources Act 1963, has now made an Order confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the Gwynedd River Authority, under section 4 (1) (b) of the Land Drainage Act 1930, making provision for the abolition of the Cors y Bol Drainage District and the Drainage Board thereof.

The Scheme affects land in the Parishes of Llanbabo, Llanerchymedd and Rhodogaidio in the Rural District of Twrcelyn and in the Parishes of Llanddeusant and Llantrisant in the Rural District of Valley, all in the County of Anglesey.

The Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament unless during the period ending with 12th January 1970, a memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a memorial (as prescribed in Article 6 of the Land Drainage (River Authorities) General Regulations 1965, S.I. 1965/443) praying that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure.
