

ROYAL BOROUGH OF KINGSTON UPON THAMES

The Kingston upon Thames (No. 17) Smoke Control Order, 1969

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 7th day of October 1969, made an Order entitled *The Kingston upon Thames (No. 17) Smoke Control Order, 1969*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1970 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Guildhall, Kingston upon Thames, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 20th day of December 1969.

Within the said period any persons who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

That part of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames bounded on the south side by Malden Way, on the west side of the Hogsmill River, on the north side by the railway line (Waterloo to Surbiton line) and on the east side by South Lane West and South Lane.

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 7th day of October 1969, made an Order entitled *The Kingston upon Thames (No. 16) Smoke Control Order, 1969*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The

authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of October 1970 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Guildhall, Kingston upon Thames, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 20th day of December 1969.

Within the said period any persons who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

That part of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames bounded by a line commencing at the junction of Latchmere Road and Park Road, running in a south-westerly direction along the Centres of Latchmere Road and Bank Lane, continuing across Canbury Gardens as far as the Borough boundary in the centre of the River Thames adjacent to the southernmost tip of Steven's Eyot, thence following the Borough boundary in a clockwise direction until it reaches the boundary of Richmond Park at the rear of No. 13 Wilmer Close, thence following the boundary of Richmond Park in a southerly direction, thence turning westward along the southern boundary of No. 160 Park Road to the centre of Park Road and thence in a southerly direction along the centre of Park Road to the point of commencement aforesaid.
