The Fishguard—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Trwyn-y-Garnedd, near Penrhyndeudraeth) Order 197 , and

The Fishguard—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Trwyn-y-Garnedd, near Penrhyndeudraeth Side Road) Order 197 .

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. an Order under section 7 of the above Act providing:

(a) that a road which he proposes to construct at Trwyn-y-Garnedd, near Penrhyndeudraeth in the county of Merioneth shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation and

(b) that the length of the Fishguard—Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road as from the 1st April next after the date on which notice is given by the Secretary of State to the County Council of Merioneth (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the new trunk road is open for through traffic; and

2. an Order under section 9 of the above Act authorising the Secretary of State to stop up the superseded length of Trunk Road.
