Notice is hereby given, pursuant to section 68(7) of the Companies Act, 1967, that the Board of Trade have, under section 68(1) of the said Act, given a direction to Midland, Northern & Scottish Insurance Company Limited that in carrying on business of each class of insurance business relevant for the purposes of Part ii of the Companies Act 1967 that it is by or under section 61 of that Act authorised to carry on, it shall on and after 3rd February 1970 be subject to the restriction appropriate to the carrying on of business of that class as set out in section 68(4) of that Act. Notice is hereby given that by an Order made on Monday the 15th day of December 1969 upon the petition of the above-named Flying Facilities Limited and of Hugh Kenneth Hughes of Gatwick House Horley in the County of Surrey a member of the said company on the 20th November 1969 preferred unto this Court

And upon hearing counsel for the petitioners and for the Registrar of Companies (the respondent)

And upon reading the said petition the affidavit of John James Turnbull and the affidavit of Hugh Kenneth Hughes both filed the 25th November 1969 the affidavit of William Peter Gappa filed the 4th December 1969 and the exhibits in the said affidavit or some of them respectively referred to

And there being no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by the said petition as appears from the said affidavit of William Peter Gappa and the exhibit thereto

And the petitioners by their counsel undertaking within one month of the restoration of the name of the above-named company to the register of companies (1) to forward to the Registrar of Companies as required by sections 124 and 126 of the above-mentioned Act a copy of the annual return of the said company for each of the years 1966 to 1968 (inclusive) (2) to send to the Registrar of Companies as required by section 200 of the said Act a notification of any changes among the directors of the said company or in its secretary or in their particulars specifying the dates of such changes and (3) to give to the Registrar of Companies as required by section 107 of the said Act a notice of any change in the situation of the registered office of the said company

This Court doth order that the name of the above-named Flying Facilities Limited be restored to the register of companies

And it is ordered that an office copy of this Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above-mentioned Act the said Flying Facilities Limited is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off

And it is ordered that the Registrar of Companies do advertise this Order in his official name in the *London Gazette*

And it is ordered that the petitioners the said Flying Facilities Limited and Hugh Kenneth Hughes do pay to the Registrar of Companies his costs of the said petition
