

*Higher maximum rate of allowance for part-time treatment*

2.—(1) In Schedule 6 to the 1964 Order, for paragraph 10 (part-time treatment allowance under Article 23) there shall be substituted the paragraph set out in Part I of the Appendix hereto.

(2) In Part II of the Appendix to the 1969 Order (Schedules in the new currency to be substituted in the 1964 Order on the appointed day) for paragraph 10 of Schedule 6 (part-time treatment allowance under Article 23) there shall be substituted the paragraph set out in Part II of the Appendix hereto.

(3) Paragraph (1) of this Article shall be deemed to have come into operation on 15th December 1969.
