

THE FOURTH SCHEDULE

*Lengths of Road in the County Borough of St. Helens*

- Shaw Street* ... .. East side  
 (a) from a point 60 feet north of the junction of Shaw Street with Church Street to a point 90 feet south of the south east gate post of the entrance to the premises belonging to British Rail.  
 (b) from the north west gate post of the entrance to the premises belonging to British Rail to a point 60 feet south of the junction of Shaw Street with Corporation Street.  
 (c) from a point 60 feet north of the junction of Shaw Street with Corporation Street to the junction of Shaw Street with Hall Street.

THE SIXTH SCHEDULE

*Lengths of Road in the County Borough of St. Helens*

- North Road* ... .. West side  
 (a) from the junction with Mill Street for a distance of 60 feet in a northerly direction.  
 (b) from a point 50 feet south of the junction with Crab Street to a point 60 feet north of the junction with Cooper Street.  
 East side— from the junction with Ward Street to a point 120 feet north of the junction with Cooper Street.
- Cooper Street* ... .. Both sides— from the east kerb line of Chapel Street in an easterly direction to the east side of the passage at the rear of Nos. 68-130 (even numbers inclusive) North Road.

THE SEVENTH SCHEDULE

*Length of Road in the County Borough of St. Helens*

- North Road* ... .. West side— from a point 60 feet north of the junction with Mill Street in a northerly direction to a point 50 feet south of the junction with Crab Street.

SWINDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Borough of Swindon (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1970*

Notice is hereby given that the Swindon Borough Council proposes to make an Order under section 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and all other powers then enabling in that behalf, the effect of which is (a) to introduce new charges for the parking of vehicles at the car parks set out hereunder and (b) to revoke orders to a contrary effect.

*Car Parks:* Cromwell Street, Granville Street, Havelock Street, Princes Street, Queen Street, Bath Road, Devizes Road, Prospect Place, John Street, Rolleston Street, Henry Street, Fleming Way, Carr Street.

*Normal Charges:* Not exceeding 5 hours 5 to 24 hours Saturdays in the Central Area  
 1s. 2s. 2s.

*Excess Charges:* A charge of £1 for parking in excess of the period paid for.

*Season Tickets* (Monday to Friday only): Quarterly (expiring on 30th June, 30th September, 31st December or 31st March) £5  
 Yearly (expiring on 31st March) ... .. £15

NOTE: Season Tickets will not be issued in respect of Queen Street, John Street, Rolleston Street and Floors 1, 2, 3 and 4 Fleming Way Car Parks.

TEESSIDE COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The County Borough of Teesside (Various Streets at Middlesbrough) (Prohibition of Waiting) (No. 1) Order, 1969.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th February 1970, the Council of the County Borough of Teesside made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is:

- (a) to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.  
 (b) to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait between the hours of 6 a.m. and 12 midnight in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, Municipal Buildings, Middlesbrough, Teesside, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 16th February 1970, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
