

The County Borough of Wallasey (Groveland Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970.

To prohibit the waiting of vehicles, subject to the usual exemptions, between 8 a.m. and midnight on the east side of Groveland Road from a point opposite the projected centre line of Groveland Avenue for a distance of 32 yards in a southerly direction.

Copies of the proposed Orders and maps showing the roads to which the proposed Orders relate may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Wallasey, during normal office hours.

WESTMORLAND COUNTY COUNCIL

The Westmorland County Council (D.277 Back Lane, Burneside) (Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1970

Notice is hereby given that on the 12th February 1970 the Westmorland County Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968.

The Order prohibits the use by motor vehicles of the D.217 Back Lane, Burneside, from a point 70 yards south of its junction with New Road to its junction with the C.15 Kendal-Burneside Road. Exemptions will apply in respect of (1) the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from premises adjoining Back Lane and (2) access for agricultural purposes, building operations, road maintenance, etc.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the restricted length of road are available at the County Hall, Kendal, for inspection during normal office hours.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the 12th February, 1970, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

WIGAN COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Wigan (Queen's Hall Passage) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1969

Notice is hereby given that on the 13th day of February 1970, the Wigan County Borough Council made an Order under section 1 (1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 the effect of which is to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on either of the following sides of lengths of Queen's Hall Passage in the County Borough of Wigan:

(a) the north side from its junction with Market Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 98 feet;

(b) the south side from its junction with Market Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 82 feet 6 inches.
