NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH VARIATION ORDER

Town and Country Planning Acts 1962 and 1968

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Housing and Local Government in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 153 and 217 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962 as amended by section 89 and paragraph 52 (c) of Schedule 9 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1968 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, proposes to make an Order which will vary, if confirmed without modification, "The Stopping up of Highways (County of Lancaster) (No. 32) Order 1967" made by the Minister of Transport, by substituting new definitions for "The Deposited Plan" and "The Developer".

The effect of the Order if confirmed will be that a new plan will be substituted which will show a new route over which highways must be provided by the developer before the footpath leading from Red House Lane to Doctors Lane is stopped up.

*Imposition of 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit—
Remenham, Berks.*
