Whereas it is expedient to amend the method of providing for the increase of the retired pay of certain officers of the Royal Navy who have served in certain salaried appointments after format retirement from the active list:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act 1865, and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows: — 1. This Order may be cited as the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pensions Increase) (Amendment) Order 1970.

(Amendment) Order 1970. 2. The Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions (Pensions Increase) Order 1969 shall be amended by the deletion of paragraph 9 and the substitution of the provisions set out in the Schedule to this Order.

#### SCHRDULE

#### Paragraph 9

Special Provisions

9. The increase to be awarded to officers who served in certain salaried appointments for which provision is made in Orders in Council dated 13th December 1921 (No. 207\*/CE), 26th May 1925 (No. 114A/CE), and 23rd July 1931 (No. 96/CE), and subsequent amending Orders in Council, and whose retired pay includes an addition in respect of service in the salaried appointment, shall be the difference between the award of retired pay, including pensions increases, in payment prior to 1st April 1969 and the sum of

(a) the service retired pay earned by service on the active list increased in accordance with the general conditions by the pensions increases, including the increase provided for in this Order, applicable to the retired pay code under which this element of retired pay was awarded; plus

(b) the additional retired pay earned by service in the salaried appointment increased in accordance with the general conditions by the pensions increases, including the increase provided forin the Pensions (Increase) Act 1969, applicable to a civil pension commencing on the date of final retirement.
