### PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

#### HARTLEPOOL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL *The County Borough of Hartlepool No. 18 Smoke Control Order 1970*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Hartlepool in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 on the 26th day of March 1970 made an Order entitled *The County Borough of Hartlepool No. 18 Smoke Control Order 1970*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke

is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the 1st day of November 1971 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Clerk's Office, Municipal Buildings, Hartlepool, at all reasonable times during the period of six weeks from the 10th day of April 1970.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to The Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

### ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

#### BEDWELLYT URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL *(Gravel Lane, Blackwood) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970*

#### EVESHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

#### *The Evesham (Off Street Parking Places) (Variation) Order, 1969*
