all at Llanfairpwllgwyngyll aforesaid and

(b) provide for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Anglesey as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

The Trunk Road (Various Roads, Dolgellau) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1970.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State is revoking the Trunk Road (Various Roads, Dolgellau) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1968 and intends to make a new Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.:

- (a) in the length of road or on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice, or
- (b) on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice for a longer period than 1 hour in any 2.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein; or to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

The time limit in (b) above will not apply to an invalid carriage, a vehicle issued to a disabled person by the Government in lieu of an invalid carriage; a vehicle left by the driver, who because of severe physical disability has been issued with an exemption by Merioneth County Council and such exemption is displayed on the vehicle in a prominent position; or a vehicle left by a driver who has been issued with a yellow car badge by any local authority under the disabled drivers' scheme and the badge is placed in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.
