A PROCLAMATION

Revoking the Proclamations of 13th October 1897 and 7th March 1898 establishing the Branch Mint at Perth, Western Australia

ELIZABETH R.

Whereas Her Majesty Queen Victoria in pursuance of the Coinage Act 1870 (in this Proclamation referred to as "the Act") by Proclamation dated the thirteenth day of October 1897 as amended by Proclamation dated the seventh day of March 1898 directed the establishment of a Branch Mint at or near Perth in Western Australia:

And Whereas by virtue of section eleven of the Act We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to revoke any Proclamation previously made under the Act:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable to revoke the said Proclamations:

We, therefore, with the advice of Our Privy Council in pursuance of section eleven of the Act and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:

The aforesaid Proclamations dated the thirteenth day of October 1897 and the seventh day of March 1898 are hereby revoked with effect from the first day of July 1970:

Provided that nothing in this Proclamation shall affect anything legally done or suffered to be done before the first day of July 1970, and all coins coined at the Branch Mint at Perth in Western Australia before that date which are at that date current and legal tender in any part of Our dominions shall continue to be so current and legal tender.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this twenty-ninth day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy and in the Nineteenth year of Our Reign.

A PROCLAMATION

Discontinuing the Branch Mint at Melbourne, Victoria, Australia

ELIZABETH R.

Whereas Her Majesty Queen Victoria, by an Order in Council dated the seventh day of August 1869, ordered the establishment of a Branch Mint at or near Melbourne in Victoria:

And Whereas in pursuance of the Coinage Act 1870 (in this Proclamation referred to as "the Act"), Her Majesty Queen Victoria, by the Melbourne Mint Proclamation 1900, directed that the said Branch Mint should continue to be established:

And Whereas by virtue of section eleven of the Act We have power, with the advice of Our Privy Council, by Proclamation to revoke any Proclamation previously made under the Act:

And Whereas it appears to Us desirable that the establishment of the said Branch Mint should be discontinued:

We, therefore, with the advice of Our Privy Council and in pursuance of section eleven of the Act and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf, do hereby proclaim, direct and ordain as follows:

The Melbourne Mint Proclamation 1900 is hereby revoked with effect from the first day of July 1970 and the establishment of the branch of Our Royal Mint at or near Melbourne in Victoria shall as from that date be discontinued:

Provided that nothing in this Proclamation shall affect anything legally done or suffered before the first day of July 1970, and all coins coined at the said Branch Mint before that date which are at that date current and legal tender in any part of Our dominions shall continue to be so current and legal tender.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this twenty-ninth day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventy and in the Nineteenth year of Our Reign.
