NOTICE TO VARY A LICENCE TO
ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that application is being made to the Kent River Authority by Anthony Coleman Ltd., The Old Parsonage, Goudhurst, Kent, to vary licence serial number 9/40/3/112/SR which authorises the abstraction of a total of 14,000,000 gallons of water a year from the River Teise, during the period from 1st March to the 31st August, for the purposes of spray irrigation.

The variation applied for is to extend the period for abstraction from 1st March-31st August to "all year". A high proportion of the water abstracted is to be used for the purposes of frost protection and will be returned to the source of supply. This will include an impounding device for directing water into off-stream storage. There is to be no increase in the annual authorised abstraction.

BURNLEY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL
CLEAN AIR ACT, 1956

The Burnley (No. 12) Smoke Control Order, 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the County Borough of Burnley in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 1st day of July 1970, made an Order entitled *The Burnley (No. 12) Smoke Control Order, 1970*, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £10 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation until the 1st day of April 1972 or before a later date determined by the Minister of Housing and Local Government.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected, free of charge, at the Town Clerk's Office, Town Hall, Burnley, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from the 24th day of July 1970.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

The area of land bounded by Ashfield Road Bridge, then along the railway line in a north-easterly direction to the railway bridge at Colne Road, then along Colne Road in a northerly direction to the Borough boundary, then along the Borough boundary in a south-westerly direction to its intersection with the River Calder, then south-easterly along the River Calder to Ashfield Road Bridge.
