The Glamorgan County Council (Pisgah Street, Kenfig Hill) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1970.

GOSPORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Gosport (Alverstoke Village) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1970

Notice is hereby given that on the 14th July 1970 the Gosport Borough Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting by vehicles between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. from Monday to Saturday (inclusive) on both sides of Little Lane and on the south side of Church Road; limit waiting to two hours in any period of 24 hours on the north side of Church Road and prohibit waiting at all times on the corners at the junctions of Little Lane with Green Road and Church Road with Anglesey Road, as detailed below:

- (a) *Waiting Prohibited 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday to Saturday (inclusive)*

Little Lane:

- (i) On the west side from a point 10 yards south of its junction with the south side of Green Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 100 yards.
- (ii) On the east side from a point 15 yards south of its junction with the south side of Green Road in a southerly direction to its junction with the north side of Church Road.

Church Road:

- (i) On the north side from its junction with the east side of Little Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 5 yards.
- (ii) On the south side from a point 10 yards west of its junction with the west side of Anglesey Road extending in a westerly and south-westerly direction for a distance of 116 yards.

- (b) *Waiting Limited to Two Hours in Any Period of 24 hours*

Church Road:

On the north side from a point 5 yards east of its junction with the east side of Little Lane extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 89 yards.

- (c) *No Waiting at Any Time*

Green Road:

- (i) On the south side from its junction with the west side of Little Lane in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 yards.
- (ii) On the south side from its junction with the east side of Little Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of 7 yards.

Little Lane:

- (i) On the west side from its junction with the south side of Green Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 yards.
- (ii) On the east side from its junction with the south side of Green Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 15 yards.

Church Road:

- (i) On the north side from its junction with the west side of Anglesey Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 yards.
- (ii) On the south side from its junction with the west side of Anglesey Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 10 yards.

Anglesey Road:

- (i) On the west side from its junction with the north side of Church Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 10 yards.
