Abingdon, Berks

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1968 to authorise the stopping up of a part width of Piling Hill (A.420) at Fyfield, near Abingdon, Berks, in the interests of the safety of users of and to facilitate the movement of traffic on the Fyfield By-pass which is a highway to be constructed in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACTS
1962 AND 1968

Bedale, Yorks

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 153 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962 to authorise the diversion of a length of Strait Lane, Well, Bedale, Yorkshire to enable development consisting of the extraction of limestone to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to the Agglethorpe Quarry Co. Ltd.
