The time limit in (b) above does not apply to an invalid carriage, a vehicle issued to a disabled person invalid carriage, a vehicle issued to a disabled person by the Government in lieu of an invalid carriage; a vehicle left by the driver, who because of severe physical disability has been issued with an exemption by Merioneth County Council and such exemption is displayed on the vehicle in a prominent position; or a vehicle left by a driver who has been issued with a yellow car badge by any local authority under the disabled drivers' scheme and the badge is placed in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.
