- (a) To prohibit waiting at all times in the following lengths of road in the Urban District of Royton:
  - (i) Rochdale Road A.627 from a point 65 yards north-west of its junction with Dogford Road to the south side of its junction with Schofield Street;
  - (ii) Dogford Road from its junction with Rochdale Road A.627 to the north side of its junction with Mellor Street;
  - (iii) Rochdale Lane from its junction with Rochdale Road A.627 for a distance of approximately 30 yards southwards.
- (b) To prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on the following length of road in the Urban District of Royton:

Little Turf Lane from its junction with Shaw Road A.663 to a point approximately 30 yards east of its junction with Oldham Road A.627.

The Order contains exemptions to allow vehicles to wait for as long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded; to enable a person to board or alight; and to enable it to be used in con-

board or alignt; and to enable it to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition and the maintenance of essential services.

A copy of the draft Order and plan showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected at the offices of the Royton Urban District Council, Town Hall, Royton, Nr. Oldham and at County Hall,

Preston, during normal office hours. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order may, within 6 weeks from the 29th September 1970, apply to the High Court for the purpose.

The Order comes into force on the 20th October 1970.

- (2) prohibit vehicles from proceeding in the roads specified in Schedule 2 other than in the direction indicated:
- (3) prohibit the waiting by vehicles:

  - (i) at all times in any of the roads set out in Schedule 3; (ii) between the hours of 8 a.m. and midnight, Mondays to Saturdays, in the roads set out in Schedule 4;
  - (iii) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays, in the roads set out in Schedule 5;
- (4) restrict the waiting by vehicles between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays to a period of 30 minutes in any one hour in the roads set out in Schedule 6;
- 5) prohibit vehicles from making right hand turns at the road junctions set out in Schedule 7;
- (6) prohibit vehicles from entering or leaving the roads set out in Schedule 8.

The usual exceptions will apply except that loading and unloading of goods will not be permitted during peak hours in the roads set out in Schedule 9.
