

HARTLEPOOL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Hartlepool (Sydenham Road) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1970

Notice is hereby given that on the 14th day of October 1970, the Hartlepool County Borough Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which is, with certain exceptions, to prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day on the sides of the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

The Order came into operation on the 14th day of October 1970.

A copy of the Order and of a map showing the length of road to which it relates may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Department, Municipal Buildings, Hartlepool, during normal office hours.

THE SCHEDULE *hereinbefore referred to*

Sydenham Road. Both sides of the road from its junction with Brenda Road in an easterly direction to its junction with Borrowdale Street.

HARTLEPOOL COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Hartlepool (Tees Street) (On-Street Parking Places) Order, 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Hartlepool County Borough Council on 14th October 1970 made an Order under sections 28 (1) and 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, the effect of which is to designate the south side of Tees Street from the point 45 feet east of its junction with Avenue Road in a westerly direction to a point 45 feet west of its junction with Raby Road as an On-Street parking place.

The effect of the Order is to permit motor cycles, motor cars, invalid carriages and goods vehicles not exceeding 30 cwt. unladen weight to wait on the side of the length of road affected by the Order for a maximum period of 24 hours.

The Borough of Hove (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Unilateral Waiting) (Consolidation) Order, 1970 (Amendment No. 1) Order, 1970.

Notice is hereby given that the Hove Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be to vary a provision of the above-named consolidation Order by deleting from Schedule 1 thereof the reference to the prohibition of waiting in Holland Road on the east side from the south kerbline of Western Road for a distance of 153 feet southwards and substituting therefor a prohibition of waiting in Holland Road on the east side from the south kerbline of Western Road for a distance of 90 feet southwards.

HOVE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Hove (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No. 2) Order, 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Hove Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to prohibit waiting at all times on specified lengths of the following roads: Hove Park Villas, Ranelagh Villas, Hartington Villas, Font-hill Road, Newtown Road, Goldstone Lane, Cromwell Road, Denmark Villas, Woodhouse Road, Worcester Villas, Salisbury Road, Rochester Gardens, Church Road, Connaught Road and Portland Road;
- (b) to prohibit waiting between the hours 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on a specified length of Goldstone Lane; and
- (c) to restrict waiting to 1 hour, with return prohibited within 1 hour between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on a specified length of Goldstone Villas.

This Order will contain the usual exemptions to permit disabled drivers of specified vehicles to wait for so long as may be necessary for the personal convenience of those drivers on either of the specified lengths of road mentioned in (b) and (c) above and to permit other vehicles to wait to pick up and set down passengers, to load and unload goods or to carry out essential services on any of the specified lengths of road mentioned in (a), (b) and (c) above.
