Somerset (Sparkhayes Lane, Porlock) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1970

SOUTHPORT COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

The County Borough of Southport (Weld Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1970
