#### **HIGHWAYS ACT 1959**

The Caersws-Machynlleth Trunk Road (Felin-Gerig, near Machynlleth) Order 1970

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 7 of the above Act providing-

- (a) that a road which he proposes to construct at Felin-Gerig in the county of Montgomery shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation, and
