NOTICE OF PUBLIC INQUIRY

The Trunk Roads (Haverfordwest) (Prescribed Routes and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1971.

Notice is hereby given that a Public Inquiry will be held by Mr. R. John, C.B.E., O. St. J., J.P., at the Shire Hall, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire, on Wednesday 27th January 1971, commencing at 10 a.m. to consider the proposal of the Secretary of State to make the above-named Order under sections 1 and 84d(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be:

1. to revoke The County of Pembroke (Haverfordwest) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1956, The Trunk Road (Various Streets, Haverfordwest) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1960, The Trunk Road (Haverfordwest) (One-Way and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1967, and The Trunk Road (Haverfordwest) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1968;
2. to revoke The County of Pembroke (Various Streets, Haverfordwest) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1965 and the County of Pembroke (Various Streets, Haverfordwest) (One-Way) Order 1965 each insofar as they relate to Albert Street, Barn Street, Perrot's Road and Old Bridge;
3. to prohibit the driving of vehicles in any of the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in column 2 of the said Schedule;
4. to prohibit any vehicle proceeding north-eastwards in that length of the Haverfordwest-Milford Haven Trunk Road (A.4076) known as Milford Road, in the Borough of Haverford-

west in the County of Pembroke, from making a right-hand turn into Shipman's Lane;

5. to prohibit waiting in any of the lengths of road or on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice; and
6. to prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice for a longer period than 1 hour in any 2 hours.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, or to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

The restrictions referred to in item 6 above shall not apply to an invalid carriage; a vehicle issued to a disabled person by the Government in lieu of an invalid carriage; a vehicle left by a driver who because of his severe physical disability has been issued with an exemption by Pembrokeshire County Council which is displayed on the vehicle on a prominent position; or a vehicle left by a driver who has been issued with a yellow car badge under the disabled drivers scheme and the badge is placed in a conspicuous position on that vehicle.

A copy of the proposed Order, a map showing the roads to which the proposed Order relates and a statement of the reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected at the offices of the Pembrokeshire County Council, Shire Hall, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire, during normal office hours.

Any person interested is entitled to be heard in person or by Counsel, Solicitor or Agent and any person whether he intends to appear at the Inquiry or not may forward in writing any objection to the proposals, together with the grounds on which the objection is made to the Inspector, Mr. R. John,
