HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

The London—Carlisle—Glasgow—Inverness Trunk Road (Gretna Diversion (Cumberland) Connecting Roads) Order 1971.

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 7 of the above Act, the effect of which is that roads which he proposes to construct east of Gretna in the county of Cumberland shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation.

Copies of the Order, the title of which is "The London—Carlisle—Glasgow—Inverness Trunk Road (Gretna Diversion (Cumberland) Connecting Roads) Order 1971" (S.I. 1971 No. 53), can be purchased, price 7d., either through any bookseller, or direct from government bookshops (H.M.S.O.).

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plan have been deposited at the Department of the Environment, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London S.E.1, where they are open to inspection free of charge at all reasonable hours. Copies have also been deposited at the offices of the County Council of Cumberland, The Courts, Carlisle, their Assistant Area Surveyors Office, Longtown, the County Council of Dumfries, County Buildings, Dumfries, and of the Divisional Road Engineer, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 4TX, where they are similarly open to inspection.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or on the ground that any requirement of that Act, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 5th February 1971, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

HIGHWAYS ACT, 1959

The London—Carlisle—Glasgow Trunk Road (Kempley Bank Roundabout to Stoneybeck Roundabout Detrunking) Order, 1971.

Argentina: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 he hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificates reproduced in the First Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 17th July 1970 for the importation of meat and meat products from Argentina, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.
