*Borough of Newcastle-under-Lyme (Service Road,  
Lower Milehouse Lane) (Restriction of Waiting)  
Order, 1971.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 8th April 1971 the Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, the effect of which is to restrict waiting to three hours in any six hours between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in the Service Road to Nos. 54-104 (even numbers only inclusive), Lower Milehouse Lane, Newcastle.

The Order will come into operation on the 19th April 1971 and a copy thereof together with a map showing the roads affected may be inspected at the Civic Offices, Merrial Street, Newcastle, during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the 8th April 1971, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

*The City of New Sarum (Parking Places) Order  
(No. 1) 1971*

Notice is hereby given that on the 5th day of April 1971 the Salisbury City Council made an Order under section 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be as from the 19th April 1971 to amend the Parking Places Order relating to the New Street Car Stack so as to permit season tickets at such charge not exceeding £60 per annum and of such number not exceeding 50 as the Council may from time to time determine to be made available in respect of such part of the New Street Car Stack and during such days and hours at the Council may from time to time determine.

CITY OF NEW SARUM

*The City of New Sarum (Various Streets) Traffic  
Regulation (Amendment) Order No. 1, 1971*

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th April 1971 the Mayor Aldermen and citizens of the City of New Sarum acting by the Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 the effect of which will as from the 18th April 1971 be as follows:

- (1) To prohibit waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. daily except Sundays in the north side of South Western Road extending for a distance of 20 yards from its junction with Fisherton Street
- (2) To prohibit waiting at all times in the length of Castle Road extending from the traffic roundabout at its junction with Churchill Way and a point 15 yards north of its junction with Cornwall Road

Exceptions are provided allowing vehicles to wait to enable

- (1) Persons to board or alight therefrom
- (2) the loading or unloading of goods therefrom
- (3) its use in connection with any funeral, building operation, or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, and the maintenance of the road or the services therein
- (4) its use in connection with the attendance of medical practitioners on their patients or at their surgery.

A copy of the Order and maps showing the lengths of road to which the Order relates may be inspected at The Council House, Bourne Hill, Salisbury, at any time during the usual office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B, or 84C of the Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to such Order may within six weeks of the date on which such Order is made make application for the purpose to the High Court.
