

PRIVY COUNCIL OFFICE

At the Court at Windsor Castle the 5th Day of April 1971.

PRESENT

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. Whereas a Representation duly made to Her Majesty in Council by the Secretary of State for the Environment that, for the protection of the Public Health, burials should be discontinued as hereinafter directed in All Saints' Churchyard, Iden, in the County of Sussex, has in pursuance of an Order in Council made the 17th day of December 1970, and duly published, been taken in consideration by a Committee of the Privy Council:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 1 of the Burial Act 1853 and of all other powers Her enabling,

is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. Burials shall be discontinued forthwith and entirely in All Saints' Churchyard, Iden, in the County of Sussex, which is shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto.

Provided that—

two further burials may be allowed in the Churchyard in the Aubrey Smith family grave, subject to the condition that no part of the coffin containing the body shall be at a depth less than three feet below the level of the surface of the ground adjoining the grave.

2. This Order may be cited as the Burial Grounds (All Saints' Churchyard, Iden, Sussex) Order 1971.
